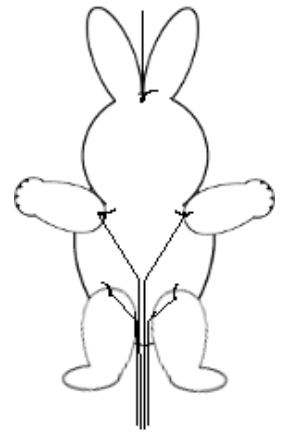


RABBIT MARIONETTE

You'll need: This pattern (printed on cardstock), crayons, scissors, paper punch, 4 brass brads, 5 – 15" pieces of string

1. Color the rabbit's body, arms, and legs. Cut them out.
2. Punch the 5 holes in the body. Punch a hole in each arm and leg.
3. Slide one piece of string through an arm hole. Pull about 3" of string through the hole. Loop the short end around the long end and tie a knot above the X. (The knot should be tight.) Do the same with the other arm and each leg.
4. Place an arm under the body, line up the holes, slide the brass brad through both holes. Bend the tabs on each brad, loosely. Do this with the other arm and each leg. Tie a string through the head hole.
5. Hold the head string in one hand and all 4 bottom strings in the other hand. Pull on the bottom strings to make the bunny dance.



This is the back of the rabbit.
