

# UMBRELLA STRAW

Here's a way to keep your drink cool and bug-free when you bring it outside.

You'll need: This pattern, scissors, crayons, paper punch, glue stick, and a drinking straw

1. Color or stamp a design on the circle. (You don't need to color the shaded area.)
2. Cut out the circle.
3. Fold in half, folding down on a gray line. Open and lay flat. Fold in half on a different gray line. Repeat until you have creased each gray line.
4. Do the same thing with the dotted lines, but fold up on them.
5. Cut a slit on the black line. Punch a hole at the top of the slit, in the middle of the circle.
6. Cut off each gray arc all around the circle.
7. Glue the shaded area. Overlap the left section and press it down on the glued area to make the umbrella.
8. Slide the paper-punched circle over a straw.
