## Cubist Cube

Cubism is an art style that shows all sides of an object at once. It's called Cubism because the art looks like it's made of cubes and other geometric shapes.

Georges Braque and Pablo Picasso were the artists who invented Cubism.

The images on this cube pattern are from some paintings by Pablo Picasso. "Guernica," "Girl Before a Mirror," "Seated Woman," "Three Musicians," and "Painter and Model."

### HOW TO MAKE THE CUBIST CUBE

You'll need: Colored pencils, scissors, glue, 6" string or ribbon.

1. Color the pictures on the cube or flip it over and design your own Cubist Cube.
2. Cut it out on the solid gray line.
3. Fold on the dotted lines.
4. Glue the side tabs. Press to hold the cube together.
5. Poke a hole through the top. Fold ribbon in half and tie it. Thread ribbon through hole.
6. Close the box.
