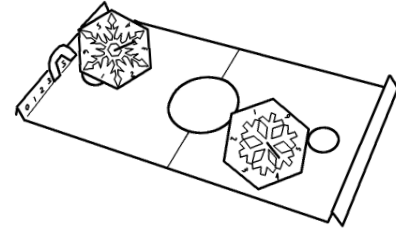


# Make a Snow Game



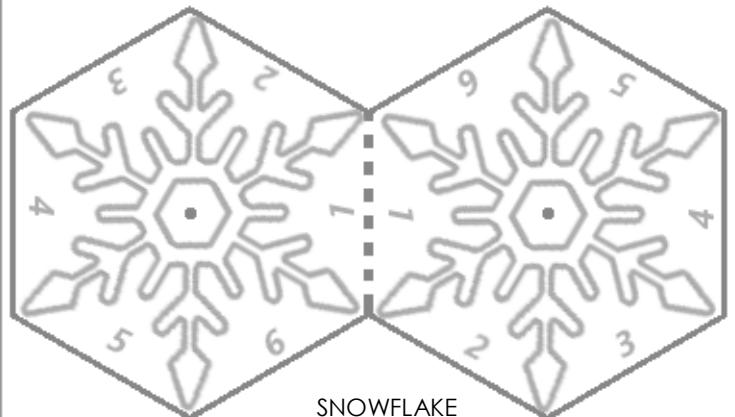
You'll need: Colored pencils, scissors, 2 toothpicks, thumbtack

1. Decorate the game board and spinners.
2. Cut out the game board. Fold the game board forward on each inner dotted line and back on each outer dotted line.
3. Cut out the score markers (half circles). Cut the slits up to the dotted line. Place one on each folded end of the game board, like a paperclip, with the number zero showing through the front opening.
4. Cut out the snowflake spinners. Fold back on the dotted line. Push a thumbtack through the center hole. Remove the thumbtack. Push a toothpick through the center hole.

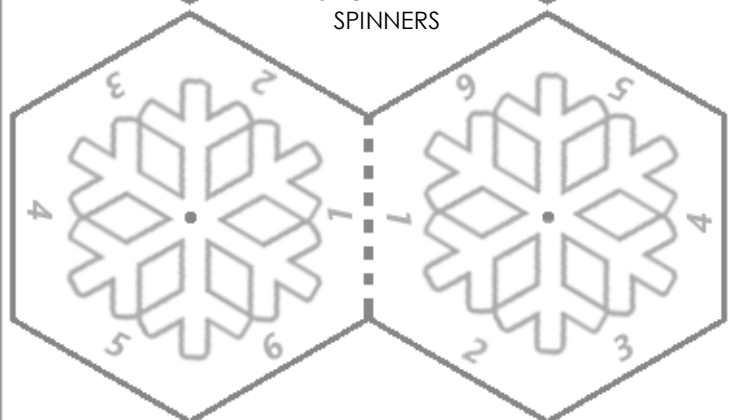
## ONE WAY TO PLAY:

(You can play this way or make up your own rules.)

1. Both players put the tip of their snowflake spinner in the circle on their side of the game board.
2. Spin your spinners at the same time. (Put the top of the toothpick between your thumb and forefinger. Twist and let go.)
3. When the spinners stop spinning and fall onto the game board, each player checks their score. (Your score is the number that is touching the game board.) The player with the highest score wins, but must subtract the number of points their opponent got from their points to calculate their score. Slide the score marker to mark your points. Play again.
4. The first player to 10 points, without going over, wins.
