Print this game on cardstock paper.  
Print pages 2,3 back-to-back; flip on short edge.

This page is the folder.  
Fold the pocket up.  
Fold the folder in half.  
Staple both sides of the pocket.


Cut out the cards and place them in the folder pocket.




## SPACE MISSION

1. Line up the space cards in the folder pocket in number order.
2. Roll the dice. The number you roll determines which cards you can remove from the pocket. (For example, you roll a 2 and a 5. That equals 7. You can take any cards that equal 7: The #1 and #6 cards or the #2 and #5 cards or the #3 and #4 cards or the #7 card or the #1, #2, and #4 cards. There are lots of ways to make 7.) Read the card or cards to keep rolling and taking cards. The object is to remove as many cards as you can. If you roll a number and can't find a card or cards to equal that number, the game ends. Count the number of cards you collected. That's your game total.
4. Challenge a friend to play. When the game ends, add the points at the top of each card. The winner is the player with the highest total.


Jan. **1958**


Jan. **1961**


Feb. **1962**


June **1966**


Oct. **1968**


July **1969**


July **1971**


July **1975**


Apr. **1981**
