Fold the folder in half.

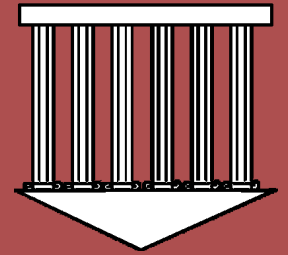
Staple both sides of the pocket.

Cut out the cards and place them in the folder pocket.


















- To play:
1. Each player chooses a BINGO card.
 2. Shuffle the picture cards and place them in the folder pocket.
 3. Players take turns choosing a card from the pocket. If the picture matches a picture your card, place it. If not, put it back in the pocket.
 4. The first player to cover all of the pictures on their card wins!
- ANOTHER WAY TO PLAY: Place each picture card on its matching picture on the BINGO card. Point to a picture, name it, and remove it to check your answer. Keep playing until you have removed all of the cards.

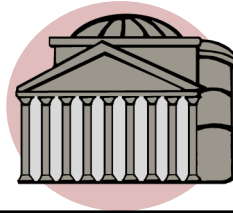
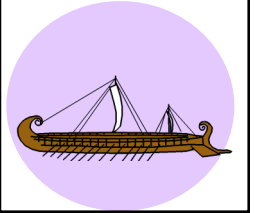
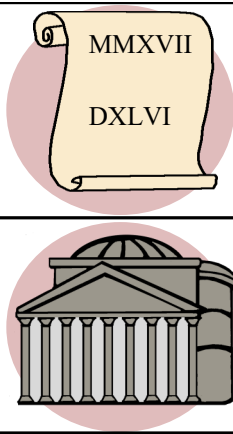
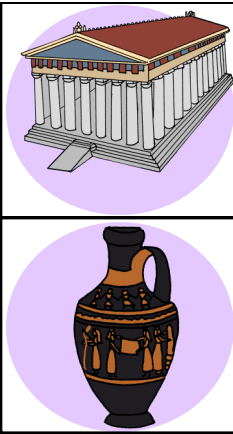
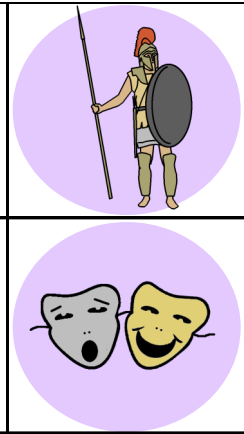
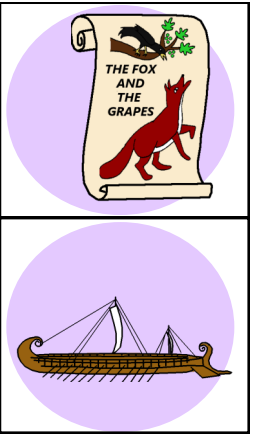
