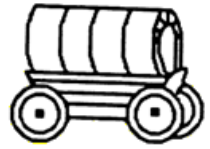
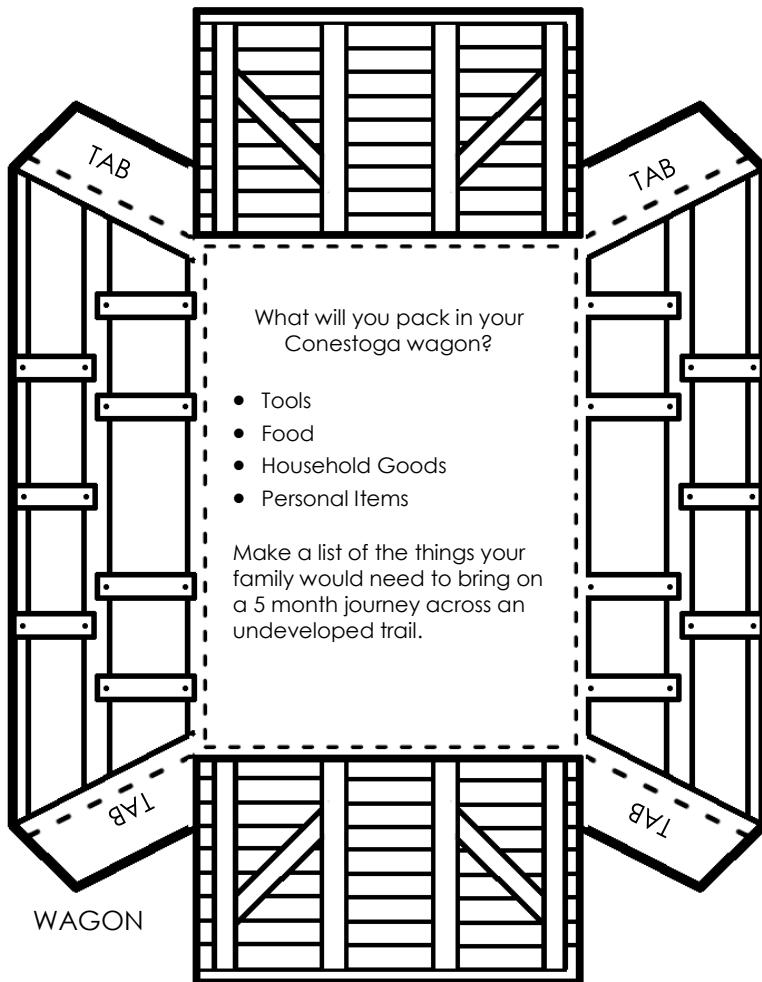
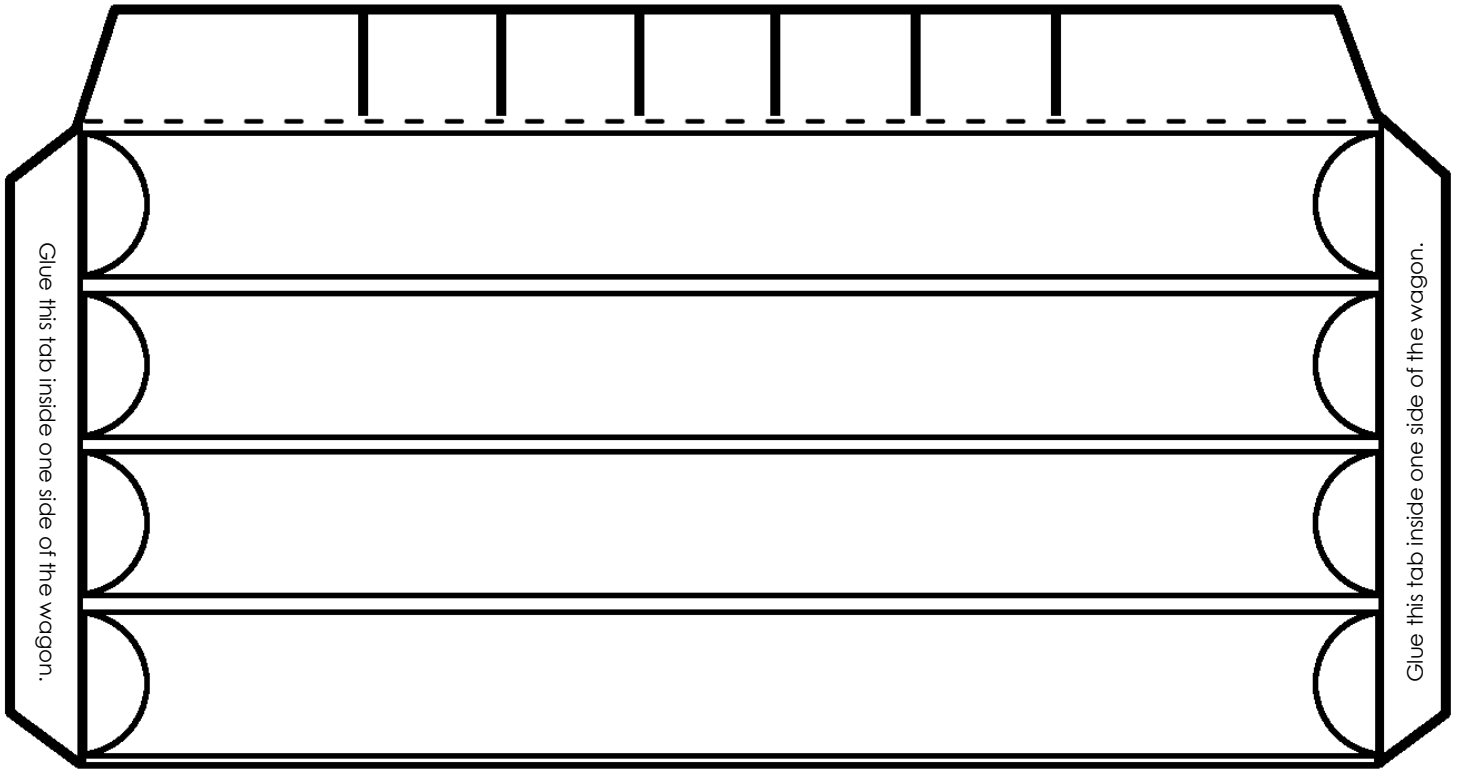


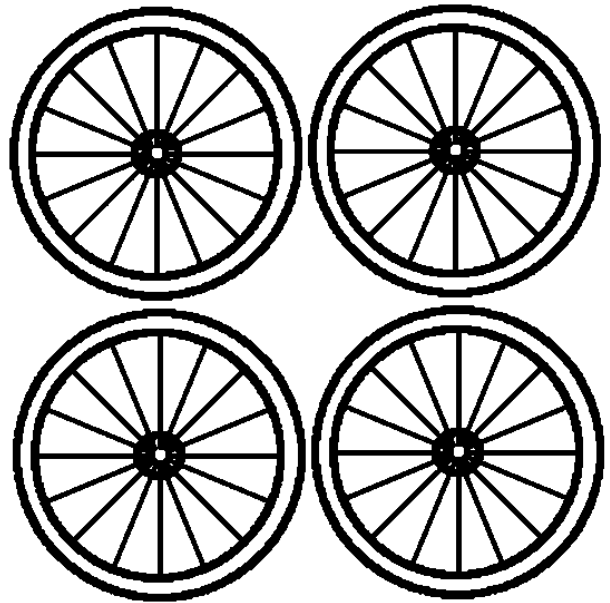
# CONESTOGA WAGON



In 1830, many pioneer families journeyed west in their Conestoga wagons in search of free land and a new life in America. The trip would take about 5 months. The family had to decide what to pack in the wagon. The weight of the items had to be less than 2,000 pounds.



CANVAS COVER



WAGON WHEELS

**To make the Conestoga wagon:**

1. Color and cut out all of the pieces.
2. Fold the wagon on the dotted lines and glue tabs in place.
3. Glue the back center of each wheel. Attach one wheel to each corner of the wagon.

**To make the canvas cover:**

1. Fold down the dotted line and cut the slits to the fold.
2. Curve the canvas top and glue it inside each side of the wagon.
